

PSHK Conference Travel Grant – Explanatory Notes

PURPOSE

This grant provides partial travel cost support for members of the Physical Society of Hong Kong to present research papers at the 4th OCPA Meeting of Chinese Physicists Worldwide (see <http://www.ocpa2003.net/>) to be held in Shanghai from June 28 to July 1, 2004.

ELIGIBILITY

All members of the Physical Society of Hong Kong (www.pshk.org.hk) are eligible to apply. Only one of the authors of a paper with multiple authors may apply for a PSHK- CTG.

APPLICATION DEADLINE

The application deadline is May 31, 2004.

EVALUATION AND SELECTION OF APPLICATIONS

Applications will be evaluated and selected for funding by a Selection Committee appointed by the Council of the Physical Society of Hong Kong. Selection of applications will be based on the following criteria:

1. whether the paper is an oral presentation or not
2. the significance of the applicant's contribution to the paper

SUPPORTING DOCUMENTATION

Applicants should complete Form PSHK-CTG2004 and provide the following supporting documents:

- Letter of acceptance or invitation to present the paper at the 4th OCPA Meeting of Chinese Physicists Worldwide in Shanghai (June 2004).
- A copy of the abstract and/or paper to be presented.
- Approval letter from the thesis supervisor(s) – in the case of research graduate students

THE GRANT

For each of the successful applications, a grant covering transportation expenses, conference registration fees and other expenses of no less than HK\$3,000 will be awarded.

CONDITIONS OF AWARDS

Awards can be used only for the purpose of this conference travel grant and are not transferable for other purposes. Should the award not be used for the purpose of this grant, the award will automatically expire.

SUBMISSION OF APPLICATIONS

Applicants should submit a completed application Form (PSHK-CTG2004) together with supporting documents to: Dr. Philip I.K. Sou, Department of Physics, HKUST, Clear Water Bay, Kowloon.
